✈️ DAY 02: DELHI FULL DAY SIGHTSEEING

- Drive along Rajpath – the ceremonial boulevard of India
- Visit Lotus Temple – symbol of peace and unity of all religions
- Explore Humayun's Tomb – a UNESCO World Heritage site and inspiration for the Taj Mahal
- Visit Qutub Minar – an 800-year-old architectural masterpiece
- Visit Akshardham Temple and enjoy the evening musical fountain show
- Evening shopping at Karol Bagh Market

Importance:

Delhi beautifully represents India's journey through time—from ancient empires to modern spiritual architecture.

DAY 03: DELHI → AYODHYA (DIVINE JOURNEY BEGINS)

-  Travel by Vande Bharat Express
-  Duration: 6–7 hours

Enjoy a comfortable journey to Ayodhya. Upon arrival (around 3 PM), transfer to your hotel and relax. In the evening, visit the sacred Sarayu River and participate in the divine evening Aarti.

About Sarayu River:

The Sarayu River holds deep spiritual significance since the time of Lord Ram. Attending Aarti here brings peace and spiritual connection.

 Overnight stay in Ayodhya


DAY 04: AYODHYA – BIRTHPLACE OF LORD RAM

Begin your day early (around 6 AM) with the divine darshan at Ram Mandir.



- Visit Ram Janmabhoomi Temple – birthplace of Lord Ram
- Visit Hanuman Garhi – dedicated to Lord Hanuman, protector of Ayodhya
- Return to hotel for breakfast
- Visit Kanak Bhawan – associated with Lord Ram and Goddess Sita
- Explore other temples and spiritual streets
- Evening market exploration

Spiritual Importance:

Ayodhya is one of the Sapta Puri (7 sacred cities) and represents Dharma, righteousness, and the ideal life of Lord Ram.

 Overnight stay in Ayodhya

DAY 05: AYODHYA → VARANASI (CITY OF LORD SHIVA)


-  Distance: ~220 km
-  Travel Time: 5–6 hours

After breakfast, drive towards Varanasi with a stop for lunch en route. Upon arrival, check-in and relax.

In the evening, experience the magical Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat and enjoy a peaceful boat ride on the Ganges.

Importance of Varanasi:

Varanasi is the world's oldest living city and is believed to grant Moksha (liberation from the cycle of birth and death).

 Overnight stay in Varanasi


DAY 06: VARANASI – DIVINE SHIVA CITY EXPERIENCE

Start your day early (around 5 AM):

- Visit Kaal Bhairav Temple – guardian deity of Kashi
- Visit Kashi Vishwanath Temple (Jyotirlinga of Lord Shiva)
- Return for breakfast
- Visit other temples and Shakti Peeths
- Explore Banaras Hindu University (BHU) and surrounding areas

Importance:

Kashi Vishwanath is one of the 12 sacred Jyotirlingas. Varanasi is considered the spiritual capital of India, where Lord Shiva is believed to reside eternally.


 Overnight stay in Varanasi

DAY 07: SARNATH & CULTURAL EXPLORATION



- Visit Sarnath – the place where Lord Buddha gave his first sermon
- Explore monasteries, Dhamek Stupa, and museum
- Optional yoga and meditation session
- Evening explore local markets of Varanasi

Importance:

Sarnath is one of the most important Buddhist pilgrimage sites and symbolizes the beginning of Buddha's teachings.

 Overnight stay in Varanasi

DAY 08: VARANASI → PRAYAGRAJ (SANGAM TOUR)

-  Distance: 120 km (one way)
-  Travel Time: 3 hours

After breakfast, proceed to Prayagraj.

- Visit Triveni Sangam – confluence of Ganga, Yamuna, and Saraswati
- Visit Allahabad Fort



Importance:

The Sangam is considered one of the holiest places in India. A holy dip here is believed to cleanse all sins, especially during Kumbh Mela.


Return to Varanasi

 Overnight stay

DAY 09: VARANASI → RISHIKESH (BY FLIGHT)

-  Flight to Dehradun
-  Transfer: 20 km / approx. 45 minutes

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel in Rishikesh and relax.

 Overnight stay in Rishikesh


DAY 10: RISHIKESH – YOGA CAPITAL OF THE WORLD

After breakfast, explore Rishikesh:



- Visit Ram Jhula & Janki Bridge
- Explore Beatles Ashram (famous meditation site)
- Visit Bhootnath Temple
- Visit Parmarth Niketan Ashram
- Lunch at Chotiwalla Restaurant
- Attend evening Ganga Aarti at Parmarth Niketan

Importance:

Rishikesh is globally known as the Yoga Capital of the World and a gateway to the Himalayas.

 Overnight stay in Rishikesh

DAY 11: HARIDWAR DAY TRIP

-  Distance: 25 km
-  Travel Time: 45–60 minutes

After breakfast, proceed to Haridwar.

- Visit Mansa Devi Temple
- Visit Chandi Devi Temple
- Visit Daksh Mahadev Temple
- Attend evening Ganga Aarti at Har Ki Pauri



Importance:

Haridwar is the gateway to Char Dham and one of the holiest cities in India where the Ganga enters the plains.

Return to Rishikesh

 Overnight stay

DAY 12: DEVPRAYAG & VASHISHTH CAVE

-  Distance: ~75 km (one way)
-  Travel Time: 2.5–3 hours

After breakfast, drive to Devprayag.

- Visit Devprayag Sangam (origin of River Ganga)
- Visit Raghunath Temple
- En route lunch
- Visit Vashishta Cave for meditation (approx. 1 hour)

Importance:


Devprayag marks the sacred confluence of Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers forming the holy Ganga. Vashishta Cave is an ancient meditation site of sages.

Return to Rishikesh

 Overnight stay


DAY 13: RISHIKESH – RELAXATION DAY

A free day to relax, enjoy yoga sessions, cafes, or riverside walks.

 Overnight stay

DAY 14: RISHIKESH → MUMBAI (BY FLIGHT)

Transfer to airport as per flight schedule. Arrival in Mumbai and transfer to hotel.

 Overnight stay in Mumbai

DAY 15: MUMBAI SIGHTSEEING



- Visit Gateway of India
- Visit Taj Mahal Palace Hotel (outside view)
- Excursion to Elephanta Caves (famous for Lord Shiva sculptures)
- Explore Colaba Market in the evening

Importance:


Mumbai is India's financial capital and a city of dreams, combining colonial heritage with modern lifestyle.

 Overnight stay

DAY 16: MUMBAI → NASHIK

-  Distance: 170 km
-  Travel Time: 4 hours

After early breakfast, drive to Nashik. Upon arrival, check-in and relax. Evening explore local market.

 Overnight stay in Nashik

DAY 17: NASHIK – JYOTIRLINGA DARSHAN



- Visit Trimbakeshwar Jyotirlinga Temple
- Visit Panchvati (associated with Ramayana)
- Visit Sita Gufa and Godavari River Ghats

Importance:

Trimbakeshwar is one of the 12 Jyotirlingas and holds immense spiritual significance as the origin of the Godavari River.

 Overnight stay

DAY 18: ELLORA CAVES (AURANGABAD EXCURSION)

-  Distance: ~100 km
-  Travel Time: 2.5–3 hours
- Visit Ellora Caves (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
- Explore Kailasa Temple – one of the largest rock-cut temples in the world

Importance:

Ellora represents harmony of Hindu, Buddhist, and Jain traditions through ancient rock-cut architecture.

Return to Nashik


 Overnight stay

DAY 19: SHIRDI SAI BABA DARSHAN → MUMBAI

- Visit Shirdi Sai Baba Temple
- Darshan at Samadhi Mandir
- After lunch, drive back to Mumbai

Importance:

Sai Baba taught unity of all religions and devotion beyond boundaries with the message “Sabka Malik Ek.”

 Overnight stay in Mumbai

DAY 20: MUMBAI – RELAX & LEISURE

Free day for shopping, relaxation, and packing.

 Overnight stay

DAY 21: DEPARTURE

Transfer to airport as per flight schedule. Tour ends with unforgettable spiritual memories and blessings.
